The award is an opportunity to not only recognize your organization's leader, but also to spotlight your organization's commitment to focus on diverse talent (inclusive of women) and highlight your brand as one that cares deeply about women leaders.

General Conditions for Eligibility:

1. The individual or applicant must be a current executive leader in a full time position in a private, public, not-for-profit, or government organization.
2. Executives can nominate themselves or may be nominated by a third party.
3. Entries must be emailed to Rachael Marangu, Director of Linkage's *Women in Leadership Institute*, rmarangu@linkageinc.com.
4. The winner of the *Executive Advocate for Women in Leadership Award* must be present at Linkage's 2015 *Women in Leadership Institute* on November 4, 2015 to accept the award and provide brief comments (10-30 minutes) to an audience of approximately 700 women leaders. Travel, hotel, and registration costs will be paid for by Linkage for the award winner.

The Selection Process:

Upon receiving a nomination, further research is conducted to validate the information provided—if any details provided are false, the entry will be null and void. The nominations will be judged by an expert team of business professionals at Linkage, whose knowledge span the work of leadership development, diversity, inclusion, and specifically, advancing women in leadership. The entries will be narrowed down and the award recipient will be notified by Friday, August 21, 2015. The final recipient will receive their award on Wednesday, November 4, 2015 at Linkage's 17th annual *Women in Leadership Institute* in Phoenix, AZ. During the presentation, the award winner will present a brief keynote address to the audience (over 700 women leaders from Fortune 500 organizations) about their commitment to advancing women and their personal leadership lessons and advice.
